Compliance Monitoring Unit (CMU)

The Compliance Monitoring Unit or "CMU" is a new unit within the DLSE that was created to monitor and enforce prevailing wage requirements on public works projects that receive state bond funding and on other projects that are legally required to use the CMU. By actively monitoring compliance on an ongoing basis while work is being performed, the CMU will play a special role in ensuring that public works construction workers are promptly paid the proper prevailing wage rates and in helping maintain a level playing field for contractors who comply with the law. The CMU begins operations on January 1, 2012, following the recent adoption of AB 436.
